

Los Angeles Will Keep Eyes On Crooks During Fleet's Stay

PLANS for the protection of visitors to Los Angeles during the visit of the fleet were completed yesterday after a careful discussion by the heads of the various departments at the police station, says the Los Angeles Times.

The city is to be more closely guarded than at any other time in its history. New York, Chicago, St. Louis, Portland and San Francisco will be called upon for experts in the identification line, and these officers will come here several days before the arrival of the fleet to pick up well-known crooks from the east, who will be sure to attend the big gathering.

The railway stations will be watched night and day. Along the riverbed roadway, the main channel by which hobos enter the city, special men will

be stationed to arrest vagabonds and hangers-on. Descriptions of well-known eastern criminals, mostly of the "dip," or pick-pocket, variety, have been received. It is known that an army of these men has made up its mind to infest the coast cities during the visit of the battleships. The local officials will be ready for the crooks, who will be put in jail on suspicion upon their arrival, and kept there until after the warships have departed; they will then be "floated."

A special force of men in plain clothes will be at work night and day. The regular uniformed officers will be given long shifts, and, with the extra men, it is thought the city will be guarded as perfectly as possible.

SURPRISE FOR CROOKS. Upon the detectives and plain-clothes men will fall the chief work. These will be scattered through the crowds to arrest suspicious characters.

Deputy sheriffs and constables will aid. The police plan to surprise the crooks by using for detective work many extra men who the criminals will be unable to spot in a crowd. The bringing of eastern officers to Los Angeles was suggested by Capt. of Detectives Paul Flammer. Officers who have worked in the slums of New York and who know most of the crooks of that city by sight will come across the continent to assure safety to the visiting sailors and to the people who visit Los Angeles to see the fleet.

Two officers from Chicago, two from St. Louis, two from Portland and several from San Francisco will enter the city unheralded and remain until after the vessels have departed. These men will not be known to the members of the detective and patrol force. The heads of the departments will meet them and will instruct them to work through the east first street and San Pedro street saloons and through the heart of the tenderloin. Any man they meet who they know has been engaged in shady dealings in eastern northern cities will be sent to jail on suspicion. The undesirable will not be asked any questions; their mere presence in the city at a time when crooks are flocking west-

ward will be enough to condemn them to a few days' penance.

"We have already begun the clean-up," said Capt. Flammer yesterday, and before long we will have the city in good shape to handle the arrival of the eastern crooks. Several of the most notorious pickpockets and sneak-thieves who live in Los Angeles have been notified to take a vacation and leave town for a while. It is the only way we can insure protection. Although we have no charges against them, they, to avoid a short visit to the jail, have deemed it advisable to adopt our suggestion.

ROUNDING UP HOBOS.

"Plain clothes men are rounding up tramps and hobos in the slums. We have detailed special men to the river bed and the train yards to pick up the crooks as they arrive. We do not expect to get any of the 'chummy' crooks until a short time before the arrival of the fleet. The men now coming in are the break-beamers, who commit petty crimes of the sneak-thief and burglary variety. They reap a harvest in rolling drunks and pick-pocketing. We have several of them in jail now on suspicion.

The eastern crooks of note will probably not put in an appearance until later. They know how danger-

ous it is to hang about town. They will be greeted by men from their homes and be put in jail as soon as they arrive.

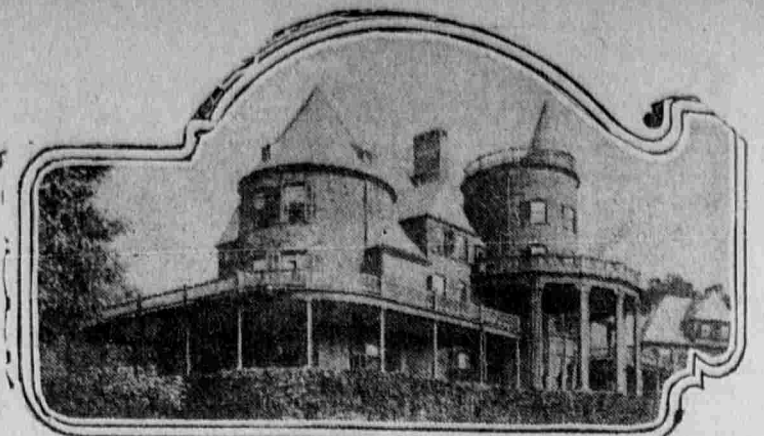
"Thousands of visitors will flock to Los Angeles and to make their visit pleasurable and to remove any fears they may have we have started this campaign early enough to clean up the city and get the crook situation well in hand by the time the ships arrive.

Sailors on shore are out for a good time. Some of them may drink a little too much. If they do we do not intend to have their shore leave marred by some crook taking them out behind a back fence and stealing their money.

On former occasions when sailors visited the city we have had reports about their being mistreated and robbed in the tenderloin.

"A sailorman and his money are easily parted but the visitors from the fleet are going to be allowed to spend their money in their own way and without the help of crooks, if we can carry out our scheme.

Visitors will be protected as well. There will be several very fine functions for the fleet and we will have to police these affairs carefully. We intend to clean the city of crooks and to keep it clean."
