One of the most serious interesting features of the proposed road is that it will be put in and maintained by said railway company twenty-four feet long in the centre and eight feet long in a line on each side of the road, the whole width inside, and one foot on the outside of the rail on each side of the track, and the top surface of said road will be on a level with the top of the rails.

Fifth.—That said track shall be laid and the road operated so as to cause no unnecessary impediment to the commerce of said city, and that the same shall be so laid and operated as to cause which it is laid. And the said railway company shall comply with the directions of said city in the construction of the line, and in the operation of the same.
