The English journals report the strike December 19, 1871, of upwards of and operators employed at the Midland Railway Works, Derby. The lifficulty has arisen in consequence of a dispute in reference to the apportiona dispute in reference to the apportion-ment of labor. A few weeks previous-ly the directors of the establishment had consended to a reduction of the weekly time, and proposed that the men should work from six to six, with three-quarters of an hour for breakfast, and one hour far dinner. On every Saturday work was to be stopped at noon. This proposition was not acceptable to the men, who preferred to work from six to five with their usual meal times, and to leave off at one o'clock on Saturday. These terms were not granted, and the men therefore struck.
