> We have been laboring now for forty Gentiles, because the gospel goes to the Gentiles first, that the first may be last and the last first. Anciently the Jews the gospel turned to the Gentiles; and, as Paul says-"Ye Gentiles, take heed and fear, lest ye fall through the same example of unbelief, for if God spared not the natural branches, take heed also lest he spare not ye." The Gentiles are fallen through the same example of unbelief as every prophet, apostle and inspired man since the days of Jesus Christ, and the cliurch went into the wilderness, and the face of a prophet, apostle or inspired man, which we live. Therefore the gospel brought forth in the last days has to go to the Gentiles first.

Sometimes our neighbors and friend think hard of us because we call them all Gentiles in a national capacity. The gospel came to us among the Gentiles. We are not Jews, and the Gentile nations have got to hear the gospel first. The whole Christian world have got to hear the gospel, and when they reject it the law will be bound and the testimony scaled, and it will turn to the house of Israel.
