A Disgraceful Mole. - The people of Springfield have been considerably agitated during the past week over a disgraceful row that occurred there last Monday, and its subsequent effects. Like most other affairs of the kind, whiskey was the cause. Some parties were arrested by the police for disturbing the peace of the place, and some of their friends interfered to rescue them from the officers, other citizens were called upon to aid the police, and a general free fight ensued, in which about a hundred persons were engaged, and a number of faces were disfigured by heavy blows that were indiscriminately dealt out. Luckily no knives or pistols were drawn, and consequently no body was seriously injured, although one of the officers is said to have got a terrible choking. The officers stood to their posts and made a number of arrests and, during the week, several of the most prominent of the offenders were fined, some of the cases being yet, however, unsettled.

Such proceedings are much to be regretted, and condemned as reprehensible in the highest degree, and all good citizens should aid the authorities in preventing and suppressing them.

Editor Deseret News: In the midst of excited and bitter political strife, in the midst of many truths and falsehoods that are uttered by each contending party concerning the other, the charges and denials that are made, the deep-laid schemes to obtain power and dominion, the flood of hard sayings issuing from the mouths of the two parties against each other, bitterly and often with malicious intent, it is not surprising that the conduct, rising to fever heat and almost to bloodshed, another Christmas has dawned upon our land. How strongly should every heart beat with gratitude to its Maker for the gift of his Son, born in a stable and cradled in a manger, through whose name life eternal is freely offered to a benighted and perishing world. The present conduct of men in high place and in low ones, poorly comports with the teachings of Him who "spoke as never man spake," proving that his religion is offering each other to beguile, enslave and rob the innocent and unsuspecting. Do such people believe that they are working out for themselves a fearful doom? Yet this unbelief of theirs will be apt to bring upon them a double condemnation. According to eastern papers, what must be the condemnation of the present political parties at the final bar? Roguery, deception and fraud is the definition of their course. There may be many exaggerations published about this; still, in all probability, there is enough of truth remaining to suggest, in the economy of Providence, the propriety of important changes in this republic. The consequences of such changes might be beneficial to the people.

If Sunday-school children can be induced by their parents or teachers, or of their own accord, to raise their voices against the sale of intoxicating liquors, it not only plants the seeds of righteousness and correct morals in their juvenile hearts, that will grow with their growth and strengthen with their strength, it likewise proves a reliable to a more mature class for their suffering such evils to exist, and the Lord, "out of the mouths of babes and sucklings may perfect praise." "Forsake them not, for such is the kingdom of heaven." If the children have been encouraged by their parents and by their teachers to speak against the evils arising from the sale of intoxicating liquors, God bless their parents and their teachers for doing their duty. A LONDON VEGETARIAN MEETING. - On Thursday evening, December 17, a number of the members of the London Dietetic Reform Society, the object of which is to induce habits of abstinence from the flesh of animals as food, dined to gether at the People's Cafe, a new establishment not yet opened in St. Paul's Churchyard. The menu comprised vegetables and fruit only, arranged in courses, and including soups, the various kinds of vegetables, seven different sorts of sweet tarts and puddings, and six kinds of fruit. The drink consisted of water, or milk, vegetarians not only abstaining from the use of flesh, but from alcoholic liquors, and a stricter part of them also from smoking. The dishes were nicely cooked and well served, and the dinner, for its kind, was pronounced a very satisfactory one by the vegetarians and the non-vegetarians who partook of it. Mr. T. W. Richardson, the President of the Society, was the chair, he stated that he supposed he had been chosen President because he was a vegetarian - never having tasted animal food in all his life. Nor did he wear any animal clothing, and he had no animal shoes, and he wore gloves. But he and other vegetarians look care to get substantial food. Flesh, he argued, was not necessary for the sustenance of the body, and that of making it necessary for heat-giving; and he maintained, on philosophical grounds, that it was never intended that animals should be the food of man. The chairman having finished his story, several gentlemen and one lady addressed the company in favor of the objects of the society; but one or two asked what substitute could be used for wool and leather, and the use of sheep and oxen if they were not to be eaten. Mr. Clark, the secretary, stated that the society was progressing, as would be seen from the report. -London Echo.
