It is situated about 50 miles from Panguitch, in an eastern direction. It is in the southeast corner of Iron County, Utah, and is situated on the summit of the mountain to the lower end, where the Escalante Creek flows through the east range of mountains towards the Colorado River, about 17 miles long. It is irregular in the width, but widens out towards the lower end; it would probably average about a mile in width.
