BLUNDELL VERDICT.

Sergeant Samuel Blundell, who, on the 25th of last September, assaulted Sergeant Knudson, with a rifle, and dealt him a severe blow over the head, which inflicted such serious injuries that the services of a doctor were required, has been reduced to the ranks and fined \$15.

This is the decision of the court-martial of which Col. John F. Critchlow was president, and Col. D. H. Wells, Jr., judge-advocate-general.

Adjutant-General Burton has issued an order approving the findings of the court and ordering them carried out.

THE PANIC ABOUT OVER.

Wall Street Has an Uneventful Day, Except There Was a Brief Flurry.

Money Holds Firm at a Good Rate—Live Stock Market: Strong—Produce Lower.

New York, Dec. 20.—London quotations for Americans did not fully respond to the buoyancy here late yesterday, and the international stocks were dragged back in consequence. The opening declines were not, however, down to the London parity. Other stocks showed notable advances, a number of prominent railroads and specialties rising a point or over. American tobacco advanced 3/4. Stocks which showed good gains at the outset were forced down immediately, some of the specialties dropping one to two points. London offerings of international and an engagement of gold for export stimulated bear aggression. Heavy buying of the steel common and preferred, lifted them four points and caused sympathetic rallies on the metal issues. Federal steel bounded up 2 1/4. Support also appeared in other quarters, and prices worked sharply upward, the international group rising to the best. A number of the minor stocks made exceptional gains, including rubber preferred, which figured for 3 1/4. A raid on Brooklyn transit disclosed round amounts of that stock, which lowered it three points. Metropolitan street railway fell 3/4. Advances in the general market ceased, and there was a movement to take profits. Sugar fell 2 1/4 and some other stock 1 to 2 points. Support checked the decline and the market rallied. With the announcement of the increase in the New York Central dividend, that stock jumped 4 1/2 points and the market stiffened, some stocks rising to the best.

There were numerous striking gains in the bond market, where business was somewhat larger.
