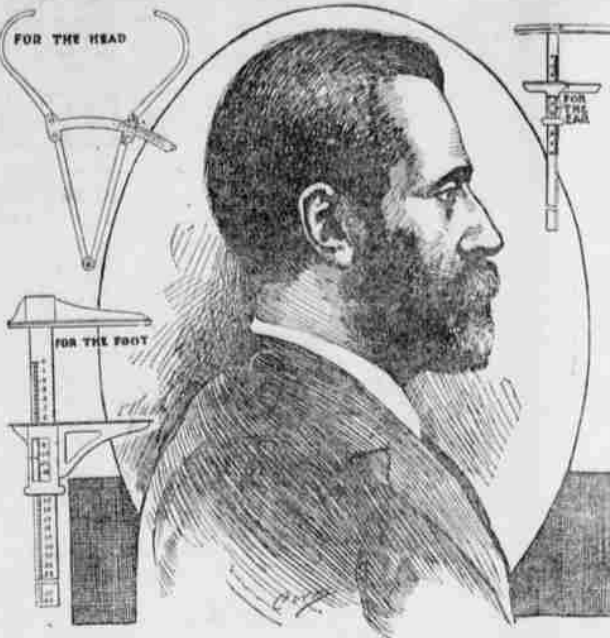

M. HERTLON AND HIS ANTHROPOMETRICAL INSTRUMENTS.

M. Alphonse Hertlon, whose testimony as a handwriting expert is showing some interest in the Deseret case, is well known as the inventor of the famous Hertlon system for identifying criminals. The system, says hands, feet, ears and other portions of the criminal's anatomy are measured; the measurements are placed upon a card which is completed by call letters and profile photographs of the criminal, and the measurements of one being being are sent the owner as a form of identification. Identification by means of the Hertlon system is infallible. There seems to be no doubt that M. Hertlon is as good an expert in anthropometry as he is in handwriting.
