Colonel Corbitt and the Stars.

WASHINGTON, 3.—The parties ac-

cused in the Star route conspiracy

continue to be confident and defiant.

Brady says the information presented

to the court yesterday is the same

document as that read to Garfield in

March last, and that it was pro-

nounced by him as entirely too

frivolous to proceed upon. He says

also that Garfield positively forbade a

proceeding by information, as it

would appear the government was

afraid its case was not strong enough

to go to the grand jury. Cook de-

clares Brady's story, and asserts that

the details of the government case

was never thought of until after the

adjournment of the grand jury on

Sept. 12. This was a total surprise

to the Attorney General, and none of

the government officials to whom it

was shown. The government is now

shielding the Star route to Col. Cor-

bitt, district attorney. They say it

was early found necessary to conceal

the details of the government case

from him. So far from being afraid

of the grand jury, the prosecution is

ready with six bills of indictment,

which will be presented at the latest

by Oct. 10th. Among these is a bill

specially framed to cover Dorsey's

proceedings. Attorney General M. C.

Veagh says although there was well-

founded suspicion in regard to

Corbitt's fitness for his post pre-

vious to the shooting of Garfield, had

that event been deferred one week,

a new District Attorney would have

been appointed. As soon as Cor-

bitt's trial is concluded, a change

will be made. Corbitt is one of

Hayes' appointees, and owes his

position to the President. He is now

Miller, of the United States Supreme

Court, whose daughter he married.

Dismay.

The dismay of the parties impli-

cated, was unconcealed to-day when

Cook opened the prosecution in the

Star route case by information in-

stead of waiting to obtain indict-

ment. The fact that one day more

of non-action on the part of the

prosecution would have been fatal

to this particular set of cases was

not unknown to the accused, and it

is more than suspected it furnished

a clue to the motive which led to

the adjournment of the grand jury
