Carlile's Statement of the Conditions of the Treasury.

THE TARIFF BILL IN THE HOUSE.

Garrison's Nomination Rejected in the Senate.—A Bill for the Payment of Debts.

Washington, Jan. 15.—In the last session of the Senate Carlile's nomination was rejected.

When my annual report was presented, it was estimated that the expenses during the current fiscal year would exceed the receipts to the amount of about \$20,000,000, and I asked Congress for authority to issue and sell bonds, or other forms of obligations, to an amount not exceeding \$30,000,000, bearing a low rate of interest and having a reasonable period of time to maturity. The majority of the Senate, however, thought such deficiencies as would occur in the revenues were best met by the revenues. The estimate then made was based upon the assumption that the sum of my financial disbursements and those of the various committees there would be a substantial increase in the revenues for the remainder of the year, but the receipts and expenditures up to the 12th of the present month show that the estimate of the deficiency at \$20,000,000 in the case of the year was much too high.

The actual receipts and expenditures each month of the year, and the monthly differences have been as follows:

On the same average monthly defences should continue, the total differences between receipts and expenditures will be about \$1,000,000.

The sole reserve has been reduced to \$7,000,000, and it is evident from the condition of the treasury that the department will have no means to defray the ordinary expenses of the government, unless a large sum of money is borrowed, or some other mode of payment is hereafter made out of that fund. If this is done the coin reserve will be reduced by the 1st of February to about \$600,000, a sum which is inadequate for the purpose for which it was created.

In view of this critical condition of the treasury, I have considered my duty, in addition to the earnest recommendations contained in my annual report, to appear twice before you to-day, and to give you a full exposition of the situation. I urge prompt legislative action on this subject. With the permission of the committee, I have prepared and caused to be introduced in both houses a bill which, if promptly passed, would, in my opinion, provide the requirements of the situation by providing the necessary means for defraying public expenses and replenishing the coin reserve, to such an extent as to meet the needs of a party of all terms of United States currency.

The bill referred to is as follows:

An act to amend section 5 of an act to provide for the resumption of specie payments, approved January 14, 1873, to provide for the payment of the debts and expenses of the government and of an act to provide for the resumption of specie payments, approved January 14, 1875, and the same is hereby so amended that in lieu of the description of the debts and expenses of the government, it is hereby enacted, that the secretary of the treasury is hereby authorized to issue from time to time, as he may deem necessary, and in such form as he may prescribe, coupons of registered bonds of the United States, in amounts not exceeding one thousand dollars, redeemable in gold, at the pleasure of the United States in ten years from date, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding 3 per cent per annum, payable quarterly in coin, and such bonds shall not less than par in value at the purchase of such bonds shall be held and used to maintain a supply of money coined or issued by the United States; but the secretary of the treasury is hereby authorized to issue from time to time such part of such process as may be necessary to supply deficiencies in the public revenue during the fiscal year of 1894.

Bills No. 2. A sum sufficient to carry the provisions of this act into effect is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
