CONGRESSIONAL.

SENATE.

WASHINGTON, 20.—Morgan from the select committee, reported his bill on the electoral count, placed on the calendar.

Edmunds said he and Teller non-concurred.

Morgan reported adversely his bill requiring the President of the Senate to submit to the Senate and the House when assembled to count the electoral votes, all packages of electoral votes, indefinitely postponed.

The bill establishing a retired list for non-commissioned army officers was taken up. Dawes' amendment requiring the President to annually appoint five cadets at large to the West, being substituted for Allison's requiring him to appoint two colored cadets, was rejected. Allison's amendment was rejected 14 to 37.

House's amendment requiring the President not to discriminate against race in appointing cadets was rejected.

Kirkwood moved to add to the bill that when an enlisted man has served as such 15 consecutive years in the army honorably and faithfully, and that he has been honorably discharged, he shall be eligible for appointment as second lieutenant in the army corps of the line in which he has served. He wished to hold out to private soldiers the prospect of honorable advancement; amendment adopted. The bill was read the third time and passed.

Ransom, from the committee on commerce, reported adversely on the bill to aid in increasing the commercial relations with the Argentine republic, indefinitely postponed.

Garland spoke on the Kellogg resolution. He read from the Record to show that there was no agreement about not settling Mr. Kellogg, but a misunderstanding.

Davis reported upon the legislative bill.

The agricultural appropriation bill was read and referred.

Garland resumed and said he would at the proper time offer a substitute declaring that Kellogg was not legally elected and that the seat was vacant.

Kellogg then analyzed the testimony making a strong case, accusing the committee of having lost testimony of value to him, and explained the testimony at large.

The Kellogg resolutions were laid aside and the majority motion was taken up, but no action being present, adjourned.

HOUSE.

WASHINGTON, 20.—The District of Columbia municipal code bill was resumed, and an amendment was adopted requiring 75 per cent. of the police force to be veterans, adopted by 85 to 74. The remaining amendments were agreed to and the bill passed.

The bill to carry out the articles of the treaty between the United States and the Osage Indians passed by 120 to 60.

The House next went into a committee on the state of the Union to consider the public land bill. The first bill was to prevent land once entered and paid for from being subject to suit for trespass in the name of the United States on account of a conspiracy between the landholder and the government.

The bill was to amend the act of 1874, to further reduce the price of lands subject to entry from \$2.50 to \$1.25.

Conger opposed the bill as a bill aiding timber thieves.

Page supported it. It was read for amendment.

Tobacco submitted an amendment limiting the provisions to ten passes, committed in the ordinary clearing of land or working mining claims, or for agricultural or domestic purposes, rejected.

An amendment was adopted providing that this act shall not apply to lands in California, Oregon, Nevada or Washington Territory.

Dowsey moved to amend that in Colorado and all localities citizens may take from the public lands timber needed for domestic purposes, but not for export or sale, rejected.

The bill was then taken up for favorable report. Rejected.

AMERICAN NATIONAL POLITICAL.

THE STRUGGLE IN ILLINOIS.

SPRINGFIELD, 20.—The convention met at 2 o'clock and waited until after 3 o'clock without any business whatever being accomplished.

Legg introduced the following resolution: That debate be limited to 30 minutes on a side on the Cook County contest, and that no motion to adjourn or other dilatory motion be considered until that question is decided, and that each delegate may select one person from their delegation, if they so choose, to support any one of the candidates.

The roll of counties was then called on the adoption of the resolution, with but little debate, resulting, ayes 288, nays 212.

A point of order was made that the resolution required a two-thirds vote, as it suspends a parliamentary rule, that the motion to adjourn is always in order. The chair overruled this on the ground that the convention was only temporarily organized and had not adopted rules of order.

At 5:45 the committee on credentials appeared and submitted three reports, which were read.

The first report recites that those duplicate credentials from Cook County, owing to the conventions having met and sent delegates, they find that the Senate Central Committee did not call upon the representatives of Cook County to send delegates, but called upon the representatives of the first seven senatorial districts, comprising that county, to send delegates. Each of these senatorial districts is independent of, and distinct from, any other republican organization in Cook County for all purposes of representation in this convention.

Having action of the ward primary before them, it was easier to determine on what substantial basis to proceed towards the matter involved. Neither of the parties calling themselves Cook County Convention was regular or legitimate, or is their action valid. Each of the senatorial districts is entitled to the same representation here. The will of the honest voter at the primaries should be represented here, and this could be done by disregarding both of the county conventions and according representation to the delegates from the senatorial districts.
