WASHINGTON LETTER.

Washington, D. C., March 10.—Senator Teller, who prepared resolutions which will be offered in the Senate at the next meeting, expressing the sense of the Senate in favor of resuming the international monetary conference at Brussels next summer. Mr. Teller says he is satisfied that there has been a change of sentiment in Europe respecting the monetary question since the conference was suspended. It appears to him that the European nations are now more ready to meet the conference under an auspicious impression as to the policy of the United States. Late in the afternoon he was seen by the press and said that the country was not primarily to reap the benefit of the enhanced price of silver, but to secure the monetary system on a basis of gold and silver.

Secretary Carlisle today issued new regulations regarding the presence of foreigners in the United States. The regulations contain seventeen articles, the most important of which are: That no foreigner shall be admitted to the United States unless he has been previously admitted by the United States consul or by the United States customs officers.
