SOUTHERN PACIFIC EQUITIES BOUGHT

New York, June 3.—Furious buying of Southern Pacific railroad stock was the leading feature of a sudden revival of speculation in the stock market today.

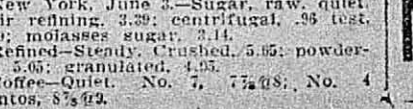

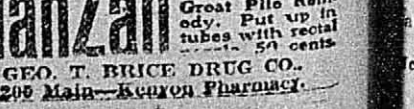
