It will be seen from the foregoing extract from the agreement what part of the city was entitled to have the gas ready for public and private use by the 8th of March, 1873. In paragraph 6 of same agreement it provides—

That if the said party of the second part their heirs, successors and assigns, shall not well and truly keep, perform and fulfil all and singular the covenants and agreements by them; to be kept, performed and fulfilled, according to the true intent and meaning of these presents, then and in that case it shall and may be lawful for the said party of the first part, through its City Council, to annul this grant. And thereupon the franchise granted by virtue of said ordinance shall revert to the said party of the first part as fully and completely as if this agreement had never been executed or said ordinance passed.

It further provides that a notice in writing shall be served upon the party of the second part by author-ity of the City Council stating what part of the agreement has not been kept, and at the end of 30 days after the notice has been served they are still in default and have not made entistanting agrangements to fulfill atisfactory arrangements to fulfill that part of the agreement, the City Council may annul or vacate the grant, etc.

Now, through the non-action of the City Council a portion of the citisens of this city have been deprived of their contract rights for the

past ten years, and I think that the present City Council should at once cause the necessary notice to be served on the Gas Company, and see that it complies with the conditions of its agreement within a reasonable time, or declare by resolution or ordinance its charter forfaited. 


