

THE PEOPLE WIN A GREAT VICTORY

Philadelphia Gas Ring Forced to
Abandon its Efforts to Extend
Lease of City Gas Works.

LEADERS HAVE NOTHING TO SAY

Mayor Weaver Hero of the Hour—
Matter Made Subject of Many
Sermons.

Philadelphia, May 27.—After a contest lasting five days, the Republican "organization," led by Insurance Commissioner Israel W. Durham, was forced today by public opposition and clamor to abandon its efforts to extend the lease of the city gas works to the United Gas Improvement company for 75 years. Thomas Dolan, president of the company, today forwarded a formal letter to the presidents of the select and common branches of city council withdrawing his proposition to advance the city \$25,000,000 in consideration of the extension of the lease, which "he" company now holds. This action was taken after a protracted conference with Commissioner Durham, State Senator McNichol and Select Councilman Charles Seger, who presented the gas lease resolutions in council.

The withdrawal of the United Gas Improvement company's offer is undoubtedly a signal victory for Mayor Weaver in his fight against the "organization," though it does not mean the end of the battle. The injunction proceedings brought by David Smythe, former director of public safety, and Peter B. Costello, former director of public works, against Mayor Weaver and his successors, Col. Sheldon Potter and A. Lincoln Arker, have not been removed from the court. The temporary injunction issued by the common pleas court was rendered operative by an order of the supreme court, which was procured by the mayor's counsel from the supreme court. Chief Justice Mitchell of the higher court has, however, sent the case back to the lower court for argument, and the superintendence in effect only until the question of the injunction has been decided by that tribunal.

In answer to questions Mr. Durham, leader of the organization, said: "We have no statement whatever to make in regard to the withdrawal of the new gas lease by the United Gas Improvement company." The leaders left for Atlantic City, N. J., tonight, and a conference will be held there to consider plans for future action. Mayor Weaver said: "I consider this a great triumph for the people. I have not yet considered how this will affect local or state politics. I may add that I have not yet considered whether the fight will be continued or not."

It was announced by the judge of the common pleas court that the hearing of the injunction proceedings would be postponed from Monday until Wednesday on account of the death of Justice Deane of the state supreme court. General satisfaction was expressed throughout the city when it became known that the gas lease offer had been withdrawn. Mass meetings which had been arranged in many wards in protest against the lease were largely attended, and the mayor's victory was the subject of all the addresses.

SUBJECT OF SERMONS.

Philadelphia, May 28.—The gas lease fight of last week, which resulted in the advocates of the proposition bowing to popular will by withdrawing the proposed lease from the city council, served as the text for many sermons in Philadelphia churches today. There were few houses of worship where the sensational incidents of last week were not touched upon.

The greater part of Mayor Weaver's day was taken up with religious duties. He attended services at the Baptist church in the forenoon and in the afternoon he taught his Bible class at the church as usual. There were almost record breaking attendances at the church, many strangers attending the services to see the mayor.

At the conclusion of the morning services the mayor and Mrs. Weaver were surrounded by nearly all the members of the congregation and congratulated. During the exercises in formally opening the Sunday school session the superintendent referred to the mayor and the part he took in the gas lease fight.

Mr. Weaver was called upon to speak a few words, and among other things said: "It's the people's victory. The people have given me entirely too much credit. I say to you, it's a victory—a magnificent victory, splendid as it has been, we must not for a moment imagine that the task has been accomplished. We shall have a long and probably tedious fight before us, but with the help of God and the people we will eventually come out victorious."

The mass meeting scheduled for this week in opposition to the gas lease will be in attendance, he turned into gathering, advocating the confirmation of the mayor's new department chiefs, Col. Sheldon Potter and A. Lincoln Arker. So far as known, the leaders of the organization have not refused to consent to the appointments being confirmed, nor have they given their approval of such action. The names of Messrs. Potter and Arker will probably be sent to the council on Thursday, and in case they are not confirmed the mayor will reappoint them at intervals every 30 days until the controversy is settled.

The injunction proceedings instituted last week against the mayor's new directing assuming office will come before Judge Robert Ralston in session this court Wednesday, when he will hear argument on a motion to make the injunction permanent.

RAILROAD ROBBER FELLED TO EARTH

Successfully Held Up Train, Was
In Express Car When Messenger
Struck Him Across Head.

HE KNOCKED HIM UNCONSCIOUS

Highwayman Was Picking Up Sack of
Coin from Wrecked Safe—Likely
He Will Die.

Missoula, Mont., May 28.—A bold robber made a daring and almost successful attempt to hold up and rob eastbound Northern Pacific Limited on the Northern Pacific last night at Bearmouth. He is now a prisoner in the county jail at Drummond, owing to the quick wit and courage of Engineer Wilson and Express Messenger Laub.

The train reached Bearmouth at 11 o'clock last night and had just finished taking water when the engineer and fireman were ordered to hold up their hands by a tall, broad-shouldered man with two pistols, whose face was partially concealed by a sash that pulled down on his forehead. The engineer and fireman obeyed the summons and were then ordered to descend and cut loose the express car. This was done and the bandit ordered them to pull out, he remaining on the engine and keeping the engineer and fireman covered with his revolver.

When mile post 81, two miles east of Bearmouth, was reached, the engineer was halted and the robber ordered the engine to stop. The engineer obeyed the summons and was then ordered to descend and cut loose the express car. The robber then attached a stick of dynamite to the safe in the car and blew the door off, shattering the side of the car. When the smoke of the explosion had cleared away the engineer was ordered to enter the car ahead of the robber, and the messenger to follow.

As the bandit found himself in the car he ordered Wilson to strike a match. As the tiny flame flickered Engineer Wilson saw that Messenger Laub had picked up a heavy piece of timber from the wrecked car and held it raised ready to strike the robber.

Wilson quickly blew out the match and almost at the same time the bludgeoned descended upon the outlaw's skull, knocking him unconscious. The messenger and engineer quickly seized upon the bandit and held him fast with ropes and, running the engine to Drummond, turned him over to the county officials. He had not regained consciousness up to a late hour today and it is feared he will not recover. He has not been identified. The car and its contents were not seriously damaged.

After ordering the messenger out of the room who had about 25 pounds of dynamite, blew the safe open in the express car, shattering the sides of the car and blowing the door of the safe. After the discharge of the three explosions the robber forced Engineer Wilson to crawl in the car ahead of him, and the messenger to follow. As soon as they were in the car the bandit forced Engineer Wilson to strike a match, and as he did this Engineer Wilson saw Express Messenger Laub ready to hit the robber with a piece of broken car. Wilson immediately blew the match out, and the express messenger struck the robber and knocked him out.

The robber was not killed, but was bound and taken to Drummond, where he was turned over to the county authorities. The express car was not badly damaged, and went through on the run. No valuable goods were taken and passengers were not disturbed. At 1 o'clock today the robber was still unconscious.

The railway company has wired to Engineer Wilson and Express Messenger Laub and will immediately mail each a check for \$1,000 in recognition of their services.

The last Bearmouth hold-up was a year ago over 2,000 feet above the sea level, by Hammond and Christie who were run down by the special agents of the Northern Pacific, Montana and Christie are now in the Montana penitentiary at Deer Lodge.
