

WOMAN'S PARADE.

A Glittering Array of Fair Women and Decorated Vehicles.

MUSIC AND SMILING FACES.

A Procession Over Two Miles Long—Numerous & Appropriate of Special—Political Side Notes.

At 1 o'clock this afternoon the Republican ladies' parade began to form in determinations at the places formerly designated by the marshal and at 2 o'clock. The first division met on Fourth Street with its right resting on Main street; the second division at 24th with the right resting on East Temple street. The third division met in South Temple street, with the right resting on West Temple street; the fourth division on the north side of South Temple street, opposite the Temple; with the right resting on East Temple street; and the fifth division on the south side of South Temple, at the Templeton, the right resting on East Temple street.

A number of ladies on long legs went over the route ahead of the parade to notify the people of the approach of the political ladies and were at the head of the procession.
