HEAVY SNOWSTORMS IN COLORADO.

A New Opera House for West Denver—Utah—State Legislators on a Visit to Denver.

The building is to be 100 feet wide and 150 feet deep, and when it is completed it will be the largest wholesale grocery house in the state.
