Holding Out to the Last Moment, the Spanish Commander Finally Submits to the American Terms-His Troops Will be Sent Back to Spain-American Army Starts at Once to Porto Rico.

Washington, July 14. The adjutant general received the following from Playa: Adjutant General, Washington: Have just returned from interview with General Toral. He agrees to surrender on the basis of being returned to Spain.

This proposition embodies all of eastern Cuba from Accession on the south to Sagua on the north, via Palma, with practically the fourth army corps.

Commissioners meet this afternoon at 2:30 p.m. to definitely arrange the terms. W. B. SHAFTER, Major General. Adjutant-General Corbin announced that Santiago had surrendered soon after General Shafter's despatch was received, the telegram

showing that the Spaniards had agreed to our terms.
