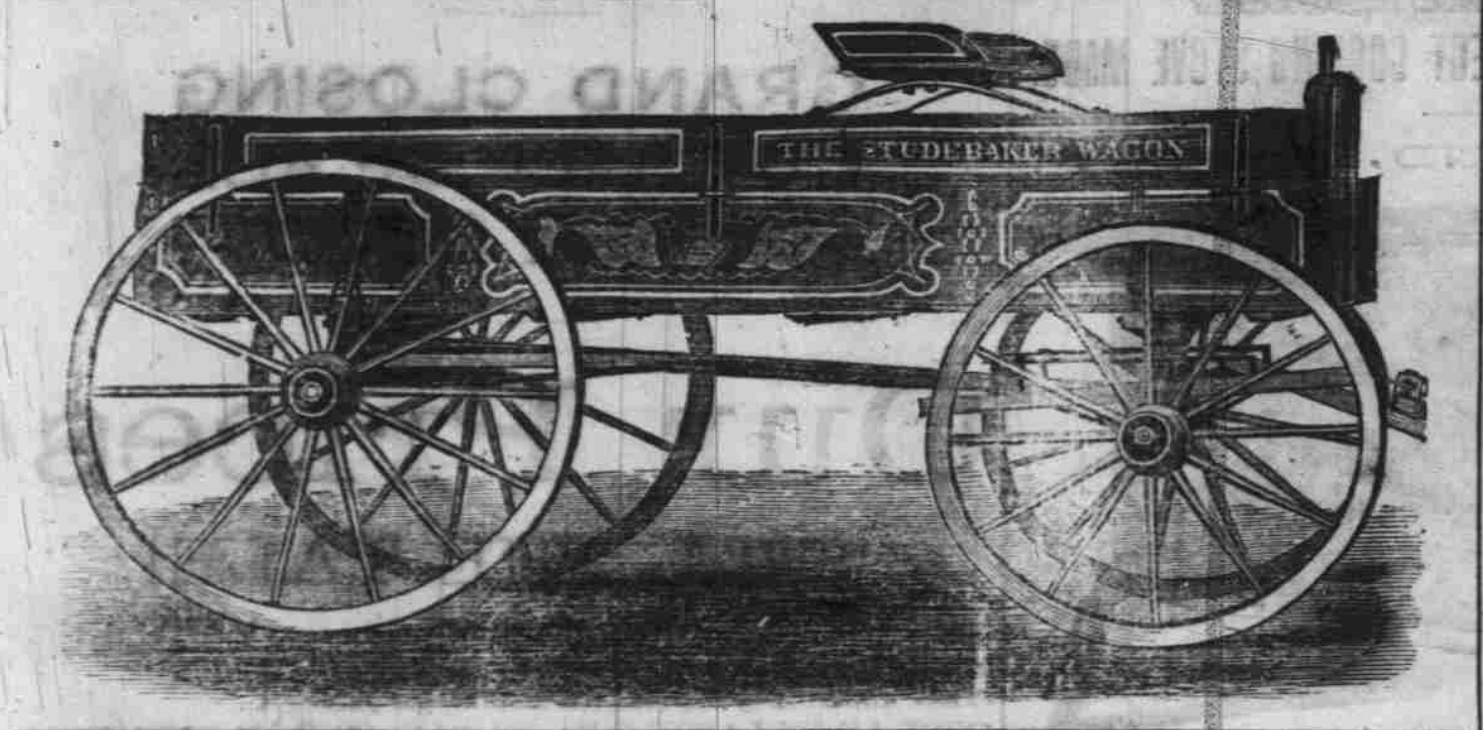

Yves Khan.
