STRIKE OF HOD CARRIERS

Practically Ended—Will Complete Present Contracts, Then Demand Raise of Wages.

Land Slide at Riverdale Does Much Damage to Canal—Wedding

The strike which the early part of this week almost suspended building work in this city, has partially subsided and work on most of the buildings was resumed yesterday. The hod carriers' union members who went out on the strike on account of the contractors refusing to raise their wages as demanded, have as yet been unable to come to any positive agreement, but have practically agreed to go back to work until the contracts are completed which have been pending for some time. The hod carriers will demand a raise of 25 cents per day in wages. Some of the union men stated last evening that they are quite contented with the wages, \$2.50 per day, which is better than the present time, and that they expect to work this year at the present schedule of wages, providing the contractors will agree to raise their wages at least 25 cents per day from July 1, 1932. They also stated that many of the union men were not desirous of quitting their work as they did, but complied with the request of the union officers.
