**Frederick Ward in a Great Historic Drama—“Superior” To-night—Wanderland.**

Frederick Ward appeared at the Salt Lake Theatre last evening as “Virginia” in the celebrated historic play of that name. His rendition of the character was masterly. In the Forum somewhere that mad Virginia is still in order to have for the approbation of the Human Decent, Mr. Ward perhaps reaches the climax of histrio-nat. His portrayal of salting emotions which are naturally evoked in such an event was beyond criticism. And his transitions from grief to rage, indignation, and outraged honor were beautifully effected. Again in the insanity scene he was so natural and realistic that many in the audience were lost.

Mrs. Bowman as Virginia, and Mr. Herman as Claudio were in their respective roles excellent. In fact the whole support mettle nothing but praise.

This play was written by Sheridan Knowles about the year 1815. It was first produced at the Royal Cobber of Virginia, when it was first brought out in London. It is one of those productions that accompanied with much enthusiasm the theatrical stage for half a century. It deals with one of the most important events in Roman history. It gives a vivid representation of the story of slavery, the master and slave, and the social and benevolent results which follow. Apple-Claudius figures as one of the most corrupt and despicable of the old Roman patricians. He was the first discoverer appointed about 450 B. C. This was a sort of legal committee composed of ten persons, who, with the underlings of the law, were to be the judges of the trials.
