AN ACT

TO PROVIDE FOR THE CANCELLING OF WARRANTS, AND FORBIDDING TREASURERS AND COLLECTORS FROM PUECHASING WARRANTS OR ORDERS AT A DISCOUNT.

Be it enacted by the Governor and Legislating Assembly of the Territory of Utah: Toat no Territorial, county, city, or district treasurer, or collector of taxes, shall either directly or indirectly contract for or purchase any warrant or order issued by the Territory, county, city or district of which he is Treasurer or Collector, at any discount whatever upon the sum due on such warrant or order, and if any territorial, coenty, city, or district Treasurer or Collector of taxes, shall so contract for or purchase any such order or warrant, he shall not be allowed in settlement the amount of -a d order, or warrant, or any part thereof, and shall also forfeit the whole amount due on such order or warrant to be re overed by civil action.

SEC. 2. It is hereby made the duy of each County Treasurer to procure, at the expense of the county, a proper canceling stamp, and imprint the same on all county warrants redeemed by him, and deposit said warrants in his office.
