DISCOURSE

BY ELDER ORSON PRATT,

DELIVERED

In the First Ward School-house,

Sunday Afternoon Dec.

28th 1873.

We will commence our discourse

by reading a part of the 26th, and the

27th and 28th sections of a revelation,

given December 27th, 1832,

contained in the Book of Doctrine

and Covenants.

"And angels shall fly through the

There are some who suppose

earth; but I wish to correct this

view by the aid of both old and new

revelation. Instead of Jesus im-

mediately coming to the earth, when

these Saints are taken into

heaven, he will stay until the

seven angels have sounded their

trumpets. There will be quite a

time between the sounding of

each of these seven; some months

will intervene; they do not all fol-

low directly one after the other in

the course of a few hours time;

but there will be a period between

in which certain great and mar-

velous events will take place. For

example, it is revealed in the

Book of Mormon, that when the
