The material selected is handled with adroitness and decisive purpose, the results of well-employed experience. The situations are well contrived and sharply defined. The piece has some well-drawn characters, by far the best being that of Giovanni Centi, a villainous Italian, a strong dramatic character part most admirably sustained by Mr. Barnum.
