MINISTER CONGER SENDS MESSAGE.

Says Allies are Awaiting the Coming of Chinese Officials.

TRYING TO QUIET PEKIN.

Foreigners to Leave for Tien Tsin—Surrender Before the News—Situation Changes Little.

Washington, Aug. 27.—The department of state makes public the following dispatch from Minister Conger received this morning:

From Tientsin, Aug. 27.—Secretary of State Washington: No important developments since last dispatch. Military is trying to restore. No representative of the Chinese government, excepting the German minister, is expected to appear soon. Generalissimo is not to enter imperial palace, leaving it practically vacant. Two thousand Germans arrived today.

CONGRER.—This dispatch is undated, but from the fact that it mentions the arrival of a German force at Peking, which has not yet been reported from any other quarter, it is presumed to be of very recent origin.

WOMEN AND CHILDREN TO LEAVE.

Rome, Aug. 27.—A dispatch received here from Taku, under date of Sunday, August 26, confirms previous reports that a convoy was being formed at Peking, consisting of the women and children of the soldiers, and the women and children of the Tien Tsin.

CABLE INTERRUPTED.

Washington, Aug. 27.—Cable interruptions continue to keep the government in the dark as to what is happening in China, and notwithstanding the most urgent appeals to the cable officials to get through from China since Sunday, one of the cable companies this morning notified the state, navy, and war departments that the Great Northern cable route, meaning the Siberian route through which cables had been reached from the north, and Japan and Korea are in part severed, is interrupted at a point between Biagovotomka and Khabarovsk. The eastern cable route is operating subject to great delay, though still open to Japanese ports.

The embassies and legations here, with the exception of the Japanese legation, are as far as better than the state department in the matter of the receipt of news.

MINISTER WU WARNED.

Minister Wu and Baron Speck von Renberg, the latter now acting as German minister, are being warned by the state department and the newspapers for information. He was perturbed by the information in the press of the Japanese action. If he has a job to do, the government will act upon it only after mature consideration, taking the ground that in the absence of any advice showing a selfish purpose on the part of the Japanese, it must be assumed that their intentions are made in the common cause of all Europeans and Americans.

It is not doubted that an American commander would have landed troops at Tientsin if it appeared to endanger foreign property and lives, and no other foreign warships were available.

Steps will be taken at once to learn the facts in the case, and one of our naval commanders will be called upon to make inquiry and report at once.

NO CONFERENCE YET TO ARRANGE CHINA'S FUTURE.

The United States government has not invited any government to participate in a conference with the purpose of arranging the future of China. Nor has it received any such invitation from any government. There is a very manifest desire on the part of the European governments to get some expression from the United States as to its purpose before committing themselves. It is believed that our answers have been framed with the special purpose of avoiding a commitment of the government to any policy beyond the points specifically laid down in the President's message to Congress.

As to the answer to Li Hung Chang's appeal for mediation, however, this may be the state department's moment to make public the latest phases of the negotiations, so it is impossible to know from this side whether or not they have touched upon preparation to divide China into spheres for military occupation; to provide a temporary form of government at Peking; to encourage the re-establishment of relations with the existing dynasty in China, though it may fairly be assumed that something has been said upon these various points.

BELIEVE THE LINE CUT.

Washington, Aug. 27.—War department officials believe that the land line between Shanghai and Chefoo has been cut by the report that the last advice received from Tien Tsin were dated Aug. 23. Such interruption would delay all messages several days, as they would have to be sent from Chefoo to Shanghai by steamer, for the trip of about four days.

BOXERS ARE CONCENTRATING.

Berlin, Aug. 27.—A dispatch received here from Tien Tsin says large bodies of Boxers are concentrating fifteen miles northeast of Tientsin.
