

## FILIPINOS MAKE HASTY TRACKS.

Gen. Wheaton's Brigade Advances Into Their Country.

## GUNBOAT CLEARS JUNGLE.

Rebels Planned an Attack Yesterday, but on Second Thought Desisted in Retreat.

**Manila, March 12.—**General Wheaton's newly-formed divisional, brigade advanced at 1 o'clock this morning from San Pedro Marsh, for the purpose of surprising the enemy. It was now nearing Parac, meeting with slight resistance, as the rebels are in full retreat.

A gunboat is clearing the jungle along the river bank, which has been cleared as far as possible.

The rebels are now moving to the country to Legazpi or Batangas.

The Filipinos apparently had planned an attack upon the dock of General Mills and General Hale this morning, but their courage seemed to fail them, though they first signals and kept up the fusilade along the American front for an hour. Our troops, in obedience to orders, refrained from shooting, with the exception of two companies of nearly-arrived men, who repaid their reprieve by a salvo of rifle fire.

This evening Mr. Dethoukay reported to the general that the rebels had been driven back, probably farther than before, but had gathered together between Parac and the village of A. A white flag was seen across the officer's embankment to lead them to the attack, and the rebels were said to have been beaten before the Americans were fired upon.

The American authorities in Manila had no information as to effect of the attack, but a general alarm was immediately sounded that a serious outbreak was imminent. They believe that the natives are cowed.

The presence of the remains of officers of disengaged, and many are now leaving to board the United States transports, while others remain to help remove the dead. Some of the rebels have fled to the hills, but there is no place for them to go.

The rebels are estimated to consist of twenty thousand infantry and seven companies of the Oregon volunteers, three regiments of cavalry, one regiment of artillery, and a battalion of light infantry.

Although the rain, which fell this morning has caused the temperature to drop, it is still warm enough to make the rebels successful by the heat. Recent soldiers were captured in the streets of Manila this morning, most of them were captured.

**AMAZONS AMONG FILIPINOS.**  
Women of Castle Attack to Bear Arms Against the American Forces.

**Tacoma, Wash., March 12.—**Official papers brought by the steamer Victoria contain the following extract from the Spanish Filipinos, the insurgents:

"Sufficient demonstrations of the Filipino women, without distinction of class, have been made to warrant us in permitting them to be permitted to take the place of men if the men perish in the struggle against the Americans. We are anxious for the safety of the independence of the Philippines. We are not that irrespective of the weakness of the forces of the United States, we will make them strong and will arm them to wage combat against the Americans."

**Otis Calls a Battalions.**

**London, March 12.—**It is reported here that Otis has received a dispatch from the Spanish General, Diaz, and the Spanish Ambassador, for the release of Spanish prisoners on payment of a heavy indemnity, and that Otis has agreed to pay the sum.
