NOTES.

The issuance of the Second edition of the "Squaw Man" by the Harpers brings from them the following literary note which view of the production of Mr. Bayley's play this week at the Fall Lake's Theater will be of more than ordinary interest:

The fact that the "Squaw Man" has just been taken into a new edition by the Harpers may be looked upon as a kind of testimony to a rather unusual literary process. The "Squaw Man" was a book that reversed custom in the making. Instead of the play, which William Fawcett had made famous, coming from the novel, the novel was made from the play. The adaptation, it will be remembered, was arranged by Mrs. Fawcett (Julie Opp), with the consent of the playwright, Edwin Milton Boyle. At the time there was some question as to whether the novel might not be handicapped by the play as forerunner. Apparently, however, the theme itself is what determined the appeal of the book.

A complete old file of Harper's Magazine was recently presented to me in Bangor, a little town in Maine. The copies covered the years from the time Harper's was established in 1850 down to 1886, and comprised 72 volumes. Fifty years of all this no one complains in the meantime, the custom was to cherish the magazine; and it is true that the magazine of the present is less a rarity than it was half a century ago, and therefore less jealously preserved. It is, however, equally true that half a century hence, say, in 1930, copy which today is lightly discarded will in its turn be a valuable document for the use. Particularly this applies to the districts which are remote from the metropolis. The big city of today has so much riches of reading-matter—as of other things—that it must take a great deal of what is precious for granted—or stop to think, and there is little time for the latter.

Mr. Frederick Trevor Hill states that some of the most valuable assistance he received in preparing his articles on "Decisive Battles of the Law" was given by a woman, Miss Mary Louise Dalton, librarian of the Missouri Historical Society, aided him in understanding the history of the law. Fred Scott says, "Miss Dalton died before that particular article in the series had appeared in Harper's Magazine. She was an enthusiastic student of American history, and one of the founders of the Missouri Daughters of the American Revolution."

Oscar Thane is one of the few lucky enough to receive praise for her work from President Roosevelt. At a speech in Michigan he said: "You will learn as much social and industrial doctrine from Oscar Thane's stories as from avowed sociological and economic studies." "The Lion's Share," this brilliant author's most recent novel, stands out among the presidents' favorites. It is a story with all the excitement and fulfilling interest that have heretofore characterized Miss Thane's work, but as background there are sociological and industrial situations handled as part and fiber of participating life itself.

Those who follow the announcements of best sellers will find good company always in the English list. Two of the best selling books in London for the month of September were "The Weavers," by Sir Gilbert Parker, and "In Wild West Africa," by C. G. Schillings, books published in this country by the Harpers. "In Wild West Africa," a book of travel and exploration, is only four places behind "The Weavers," which heads the list.
