

**TAXATION IN ENGLAND.**—A carefully prepared statement of the British Exchequer shows that since 1850 various taxes, amounting to \$213,566,920, have been repealed by the English Parliament, whilst in the same period new taxes, amounting to \$137,242,980, have been imposed. This shows an actual diminution during the past sixteen years of \$79,322,940 in the annual amount of taxes imposed upon the people of Great Britain.

**COAL IN ALABAMA.**—A late number of the Montgomery Mail says: "The coal beds of Alabama, according to Prof. Tuomy, are more extensive than those of Pennsylvania. The coal products of Pennsylvania are not less than \$40,000,000 annually; whereas the cotton crop of Alabama, under the present system, will not exceed \$20,000,000. By developing the coal interests of the State, it will be seen, therefore, that not only would the vacuum produced by loss in the cotton interest be filled, but the State would receive more money from the sale of coal than it would from the growth and sale of cotton. What Pennsylvania is to the Atlantic States Alabama may become to the Gulf States."
