## HUNDREDS KILLED.

Peligrose Attack at Mohammedan Village in Turkey.

## THE HOUSES SET FIRE TO

at No. Women and Children Immediately Slaughtered When trying to Escape.

CHAMBERSBURG, Aug. 19.—Reports from recent reports of the recent attack of a band of Bulgarians upon the Mohammedan village of Duspat, near the Turkish frontier in the Rudege mountains, as exclusively related to the Associated Press are as follows: The attack, it appears, occurred at dawn, and while the villagers were asleep. The Bulgarians made demands and set fire to houses when the inhabitants tried to escape. Men, women and children, it is claimed, were killed indiscriminately, and according to one version of the facts, all persons were killed.

## EXCITED CHINAMEN.

Open Meeting in New York, Directed by the Police.

New York, Aug. 20.—It was agreed last night that there would be trials in Chinatown owing to the differences existing between the rival Chinese societies, respectively known as the Yip-Soo and the Yip-Tsai, which are two powerful organizations of similar names in San Francisco. The trouble originated over a business quarrel in the latter part of last month, when the Yip-Soo sent a number of their men to San Francisco, and there has been a desire on the part of the rivals to boycott each other.

Chin Fong, a well known Chinese merchant, who owns a restaurant in Chinatown, was shot on the sidewalk last night and addressed a large crowd of his countrymen.

Anting Chung Jenny, of the Ellsworth street station, in a skirmish with the police, was severely wounded in the morning, and as soon as the excitement became demonstrative Chin Fong was forced to desist. The police dispersed the crowd. This put a stop to the quarrel, but did not end the desire of the Chinese to settle their differences, and there has been a desire on the part of the rivals to boycott each other.

In many cases the dealer was prominently selling it as good milk, because because were not able to prove that it was adulterated, and so the dealers got off scot-free. In some cases the milk had been entirely watered, and in others it had been both watered and diluted. In many cases cream had been added, laking in nutritive value.

## INVESTIGATION PROCEEDING.

Advice Received by the Chinese Minister at Washington.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 20.—The Chinese government, which has recently been received by the Chinese minister at Washington, has appointed Acting Secretary Ades and Third Assistant Secretary Hook.

Chinese Garment.

CAMBODIA, Aug. 19.—The Chinese government, which has received several copies of the Chinese press, has issued a decree forbidding Chinese pedlers emigrating to Cambodia, and the sale of the products of the big companies. The decree applies in all parts of the United States and purports to be the work of
