The Vendetta Settled.

CHARLESTON, West Virginia, Jan. 30.—In order to quell the outrages being perpetrated between the McCoy and Hatfield families, Governor Wilson ordered sixty armed militiamen to the state capital in this city tomorrow night for further orders. Gov. Wilson today requested the Governor of Kentucky to send soldiers to the front from his state. The Camden and Clement guards today entered their services to aid in suppressing the border war.

Later.—The vendetta between the Hatfields, Logans and McCoys, Kentucky, is settled for the present. The agent whom Governor Wilson sent to Logan County some days ago returned this afternoon, and reported the beligerent on both sides have disbanded and the trouble ended. Governor Wilson has countermanded the order calling out the militia, and has ordered the house enroute for this city for the purpose of going to the frontier to return to their homes.

WASHINGTON.

Supreme Court Decisions—Mrs. Logan's case.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 30.—The Supreme Court today reversed the decision of the lower court in the case of George F. Hall vs. the Western Union Telegraph Company. Hall wired his brother at Oil City, Pennsylvania, to buy 10,000 barrels of petroleum. The message was not delivered until after the exchange closed. Next morning petroleum advanced cents and Hall claimed, by reason of the delay in delivering the message promptly, he lost \$100,000. The court held that Hall suffered no actual loss as there was no transaction in fact made, and there being neither a purchase nor a sale, there was no actual difference between the sums paid and the sums received. The court also held that Hall was not entitled to recover the cost of transmitting the delayed message. The case was remanded with directions to enter judgment for the amount of \$100,000 in favor of the plaintiff.
