There is rare tribute to Edwin Lefèvre's "Golden Flood" in the fact that an old-time publisher and well known retail bookseller, whose business has been carried on by the reading public, has been interested in the first installment of "The Golden Flood," as it appeared in McClure's Magazine, that advance copies had to be sent him of the conclusion. The author of one of the four books above mentioned, is by a writer whom it is said is the author of a dozen novels. Does he, in his desire to review which will be anonymous, untroubled by recollections of those other books? Is the man who wrote "The House of Cards" unwilling to disclose his identity simply because his publications have hitherto been outside the realm of fiction and he fears that his novel will be taken up from a wrong point of view? Why does the author of "Sturm und Calm" choose to remain unknown, despite the compliments that greet his work? Plunging curiously can hardly be the motive of anonymity; for an anonymous book needs to be specially good in order to succeed. Readers have dubious feelings concerning the true identity of the author of "Elizabeth and Her German Garden," and they would like to know just who wrote "The Garden of a Committee's Wife" (a novelist who is represented among the top books). The signs of the beginning—At the sign of the Fox—would save two straws about either of those mysterious individuals unless they had proved themselves capable of
