State Coal Mine Inspector Tender His Resignation to Gov. Cutler.

OFFICE EXPENSE INADEQUATE

Blames Recent Legislature for "Trimming" Allowances Too Close—May Go to U. P.

There was no little surprise in administration circles today, when Gomer Thomas, state inspector of coal mines, tendered his resignation to Gov. Cutler, to take effect April 26.

The sum was but \$500, whereas the legislature of two years ago appropriated \$1,000 for the same purpose, and that was regarded as scant.

Mr. Thomas argues, makes it impossible to remain in the office. He expressed his regret at the laying down of his official responsibilities at this time, and thanked Gov. Cutler for the courtesies received from him in the past.
