

CHINESE TO RECEIVE DECENT TREATMENT

President is Determined that the
Same Courtesy Shall be Shown
Them Accorded Others.

LAW WILL STILL BE OBSERVED.

U. S. Diplomatic and Consular Repre-
sentatives Must See that Exempt
Classes Have Proper Certificates.

Washington, June 25.—The direction of President Roosevelt action has been taken by the administration which not only will facilitate the landing in this country of Chinese of the exempt classes, but will also eliminate from the immigration bureau such administrative features as have been the subject of criticism by Chinese. It is declared to be the intention of the president to see that Chinese merchants, travelers, students and others of the exempt classes shall have the same courtesy shown them by officers of the immigration bureau as is accorded citizens of the most favored nations.

Representations have been made to the president that in view of alleged harsh treatment accorded to many Chinese seeking a landing in the United States, the commercial guilds of China have determined to institute a boycott on American manufacturers. This representation, backed by the authorities of the American Asiatic society, and commercial bodies throughout the country, induced the president to make an investigation of the immigration bureau, a view to remedying the evils complained of, if they are found to exist.

The subject was discussed thoroughly with Secretary McCall, of the department of commerce and labor, who has supervision of the immigration bureau.

PRESIDENT'S ORDERS.
As the result of the inquiry orders have been issued to the diplomatic and consular representatives of the United States in China by the president himself that they must look closely to the performance of their duties under the exclusion law and see to it that members of the exempt classes coming to this country are provided with proper certificates. These certificates will be accepted at any port in the United States and will guarantee the bearer against any harsh or discourteous treatment. Such treatment, if indulged in, will be the cause of the instant dismissal of the offending official, who may be.

In addition, the president's orders say, McCall has issued instructions to the immigration officers which it is believed will remedy the difficulty heretofore complained of by the Chinese government and individuals. It is anticipated that the prompt action taken by the government to meet any objections by the Chinese will eliminate the possibility of serious trade difficulties between China and the manufacturers of this country.

OFFICIAL CORRESPONDENCE.
The text of the official correspondence and orders on the subject was made public today by authority of President Roosevelt. The president's orders to the diplomatic and consular officers of this country in China were transmitted through the state department and are as follows:

"The White House, Washington, D. C., June 24, 1905.—To Ambassadors of State: The state department will immediately issue a circular to all our diplomatic and consular representatives in China setting forth the following facts and stating that it is issued by direct order of the president:

"Under the laws of the United States and in accordance with the spirit of the treaties negotiated between the United States and China, all Chinese of the exempt classes, such as students, teachers, merchants, and others, are absolutely prohibited from coming to the United States for the purpose of the government of the United States is to show the widest and kindest courtesy toward all merchants, teachers, students and travelers who may come to the United States, as well as toward all Chinese officials or representatives in any capacity of the Chinese government. All individuals of the exempt classes are allowed to come and go of their own free will and accord, and are to be given all the rights, privileges, immunities and exemptions accorded to citizens and subjects of the most favored nations. The president has issued special instructions through the secretary of commerce and labor that while labor must be excluded, excluded the law must be enforced without harshness and that all unnecessary

Early inconvenience and annoyance to
said these persons entitled to enter
the United States must be scrupulously
avoided. These officials of the im-
migration department have been told
that no harshness in the administration
of the law will for moment be in-
creased, and that any discourtesy shown
to Chinese persons by any official of
the government will be cause for im-
mediate dismissal from the service.

The status of those Chinese entitled
freely to enter the United States is
primarily determined by the certificates
provided for under section 6 of the
act of Congress July 3, 1894. Under
this law the diplomatic and consular
representatives of the United States
have by direction of the president been
instructed before visiting any Chinese
person or persons to see that they
strictly comply with the requirements
of that portion of section 6 which
provides as follows:

"And such diplomatic representative
or consular representative who enters
empowered, and it shall be his duty
before entering such certificate as
aforesaid, to examine into the truth of
the statements set forth in said certificate,
and if he shall find upon examination
that said certificate is untrue, it shall
be his duty to refuse to endorse the
same."

"The certificate thus issued becomes
prima facie evidence of the facts set
forth therein. The immigration offi-
cials have now been specifically in-
structed to accept these certificates,
which are not to be upset unless good
reason can be shown for so doing. This
is, in the past, it has been, the
most difficult of the Chinese, who
have been recklessly issued thousands
of such certificates which were not
true and reckless has also been
shown in the past by the representative
of the American consular service
in visiting these certificates of such
real value that it is safe to accept
them here in the United States. This
will result in doing away with most
of the causes of complaint that have
arisen. The Chinese students, merchant
or traveler will thereby secure before
leaving China a certificate which will
guarantee him against any improper
treatment. But in order that this plan
may be carried out it is absolutely
necessary that the diplomatic and con-
sular officers, instead of treating cer-
tificates as mere pieces of paper, as
heretofore, shall understand that this
is one of their most important func-
tions. They must not issue any such
certificate unless they are certain
that the person to whom it is issued
is entitled to it and they will be held
to a most rigid accountability for the
manner in which they perform this
duty."

If there is reason to believe that
any certificate has been improperly issued,
or is being improperly used, a thorough
investigation will be made into the
matter. The only way in which possi-
bly, while fully carrying out the pro-
vision of the law against the immigra-
tion of Chinese laborers, skilled or un-
skilled, to secure the fullest courtesy
and consideration for all Chinese per-
sons of the exempt classes, such as
officials, travelers, merchants, students
and the like, is through the careful and
conscientious action of our diplomatic
and consular representatives under the
proposed policy of the department of
commerce and labor. The change will
simplify the whole administration of
the law but it cannot be made perma-
nent unless the diplomatic and consular
representatives of the United States
are to it that no certificate is issued
with their use unless the person re-
ceiving it clearly comes within one of
the exempt classes and is fully entitled
to the privileges the certificate secures
for him. Accordingly, all our diplo-
matic and consular representatives in
China are warned to perform this most
important duty with the utmost care."

"THEODORE ROOSEVELT."
These orders are supplemented by a
circular from the president. Secretary
McCall setting out the provisions of
the law under which the bureau of im-
migration operates in relation to
Chinese immigrants and by the new
instructions issued to immigration offi-
cers regarding their treatment of
Chinese who may come to the United
States.

The president and Mr. McCall believe
that the instructions will insure to
Chinese the same fair and courteous
treatment that is accorded to people of
other nationalities. Secretary McCall
letter to the president and his instruc-
tions to the immigration officers follow:

SECY. McCALL'S LETTER.
Washington, June 24, 1905. The
President.—Referring to the matter of
the enforcement of the Chinese exclu-
sion laws I have the honor to advise
you that I have been thinking of the
questions raised, and that I find the
situation to be as follows:

"For the purpose of considering the
enforcement of the exclusion law Chinese
subjects coming to the United States
may be arbitrarily divided into two
classes:

"First, registered Chinese laborers
who are returning to the United States
within one year after departure there-
from.
"Second, Chinese subjects being mer-
chants, students or others who are al-
lowed to enter the United States and to
come and go of their own free will
and accord, and are to be given all
the rights, privileges and immunities
which are accorded to the citizens and
subjects of the most favored nation if
in possession of what for the sake of
convenience is generally known as a
section 6 certificate, unless they have
resided as such in the United States
and are returning thereto within one
year after departure therefrom.

"Section 4 of the act of May 6, 1892,
as amended by the act of July 3, 1894,
now in force and effect provides in ef-
fect that every Chinese person other
than a laborer who may be entitled to
travel in transit to come within the
United States and who shall be able to
show within the United States, shall
obtain the permission of and be iden-
tified as an entitled by the Chinese
government or other such foreign gov-
ernment of which at the time such
Chinese person shall be a subject in
such case to be evidenced by a certificate
to be issued by such government. The

law requires that this certificate shall
show such permission, with the name
of the permitted person in his or her
proper signature, that the certificate
shall state the individual family and
tribal name in full, title or official
rank if any, the age, height and all
peculiarities, former and present oc-
cupation and professions, and where
any and how long pursued the
place of residence of the person to
whom the certificate is issued and that
such person is entitled by law to come
within the United States.

"If the person so applying is a mer-
chant the certificate must state in ad-
dition to the above requirements, the
nature of the business carried on by
him prior to and at the time of his
application as aforesaid. If the certi-
cate is sought for the purpose of
travel for curiosity it must also state
whether the applicant intends to pass
through or travel within the United
States, to enter or leave the United
States, or to reside in the United States
standing in the country from such cer-
tificate is desired. The law further
provides as follows:

"The certificate provided for in
this act, and the identity of the per-
son named therein shall, before such
person goes on board any vessel to pro-
ceed to or from the United States, be
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
