The number of rainy days during the year was 105. Relative humidity (per cent.)—The mean relative humidity for the year was 55; average at 6 a. m., 60; at 9 a. m., 65.

Weather.—The number of clear days during the year was 27, partly cloudy 124, mostly cloudy 30, days on which it rained or snowed 56, and of rain 56, 144. There was about 60 per cent. of sunshine during the year. Number of days with high winds, 11; number of days with hail, 10; number of days with snow, 35.

Wind.—The total movement of the wind during the year was 52,877 miles or an average of 1,352 miles per month. The highest velocity during the year was 41 miles per hour from the north-west on February 23, and from the north on May 1st. The average daily velocity for the year was 6 miles per hour. The highest velocity recorded during the past 22 years was 60 miles per hour on April 6, 1893. Prevailing direction south-west.

January Forecast.

The following data, covering a period of twenty-one years, have been compiled from the weather bureau records at Salt Lake City, Utah.

MEAN TEMPERATURE.—Mean of normal temperature, 29°. The warmest month was that of 1897, with an average of 33°. The coldest month was that of 1891, with an average of 25°. The highest temperature was 64° on January 23, and 20th, 1897. The lowest temperature was 25° on January 20, 1891, recorded at Snowflake, Oregon. Frost occurred in January, October 12th. Average date on which ice "chilling" first occurred, in spring, April 20.

PRECIPITATION (RAIN AND MELTED SNOW).—Average for the month, 1.43 inches. Average number of days with 0.1 or more of rain, 11. The greatest monthly precipitation was 2.97 inches in 1891. The least monthly precipitation was 0.29 inches in 1890. The greatest amount of precipitation recorded in any twenty-four consecutive hours (records extending to winter of 1894-5 only) was 6.1 inches on January 14, 1891.

WIND.—The prevailing winds have been from the southeast. The highest velocity of the wind was 45 miles from the southeast on January 20, 1879, and 45 miles per hour on January 9, 1885.

WATER RATES.—The water rates for the last six months of the present fiscal year, i. e., from July 1st, 1896, to July 1st, 1897, are now due and payable. All delinquent accounts are hereby notified that their water is liable to be shut off now at any time without further notice.
