STOCKS STILL GOING HIGHER.

SACRAMENTO MILL TO GO UP AT ONCE

Activity of Market Continues and Better Prices Prevail.

HEAVY OUTSIDE BUYING

WILL BE READY ON JUNE 1.

OF DAILY-West, Ajax and Yankee Force Entire Lists Up—Business Today, 66,566 Shares, \$41,831.

On the exchange this morning trading was very heavy and the entire list ruled higher in sympathy with Ajax, Daily-West, Con, Mercer and Yankee. Ajax is being heavily bought by strong outside interests and the stock ruled several cents higher this morning. Con, Mercer brought prices above 23 and Con, Mercer was very strong at above 1.90. It is quite generally believed that at the directors' meeting on Monday next monthly dividends will be decided upon. Daily-West is still strongly supported and sold up to 75.50, however reacting to 25.50 at the close on rumors that the buying orders had all been filled. May Day was somewhat weaker and Uncle Sam around 294 was held strong.

Yankee sold at 2.75 at which it was held at the close.

The Ben Butler has a car of good ore on today's market.

The Yankee will tomorrow market six cars of high grade galena ore.

Four cars of Mammoth ore was received at the smelter this morning.

Five cars of copper matte from the Bingham smelter are at the sampler today. They were postmarked a month ago.

POCKET OF IRON ORE.

Renzo, Nev., March 20.—Word was received last evening that a pocket of iron ore had been encountered in the Harris mine southeast of Washoe City, assaying \$200 to the ton. This mine had produced in the neighborhood of \$300,000.

Many years ago a tunnel was started from the original shaft which struck a pocket containing \$40,000 in gold.

The Tomboy Gold and Copper company of Bingham has levied an assessment of 5¢ cent a share upon its capital stock.

It is understood that the report on the Yankees Con, recently made by Jas. Nell, the mining expert, will soon be submitted to the listing committee of the Boston exchange.

The Consolidated Mercer directors are scheduled to meet on Monday when the question of dividends will be discussed.

It is stated as very probable that monthly dividends will be ordered instead of quarterly as heretofore.
