In Subject to Assessment for Special School Taxes.

NO SAYS COUNTY ATTORNEY MURPHY.

Full Text of the Opinion as Delivered Before the County Court.

The following important opinion from County Attorney Murphy was delivered at the meeting of the County court at 8 o'clock yesterday afternoon:

Mr. William Lynch, Assessor Salt Lake County.

Whereas You have submitted to me the question of whether or not a school district has been created and duly established under the laws of the State of Utah, and
