

CHANGED RESULTS.

Recount in the Third Precinct Alters the Results.

CONTROL OF THE CONVENTION.

May Be Reversed by John Henry Smith and to H. Henry being Counted Out.

It was close to 6 o'clock yesterday afternoon when the Utah Commission decided to take action with respect to the Third precinct of Salt Lake City, the result in which, as stated in yesterday's News, was close to a tie to suggest an appeal to a recount of the entire vote of that precinct. John Henry Smith and George R. Henry, the Republican candidates, had secured the legal formality of filing a protest against the result.

At the hour named the following figures were given out as the result of the Commission's canvass in that lake county of the entire for delegates to the Constitutional Convention, as shown by the judges' tally sheets:

Commonwealth's interest introduced the following: Whereas, The delegates in the Third precinct, Salt Lake City, are such that the Constitution cannot decide which of the candidates for the Constitutional Convention are elected. Resolved, That we open the ballot boxes to determine the result.

This resolution was submitted by the Republicans, and was passed by a vote of 3 to 2, all the commissioners being present.

The ballot boxes were taken up, but in that for poll No. 3 the key was broken to the lock, so it was set aside. No. 2 was unlocked and counted. In this poll the judges' return showed persons voting: Rock 60, and 30, and tally of votes out 400. By the recount the result was made to stand (comparison being given with the judges' count) as follows:
