CHICAGO, 7.—It is understood that the President and members of the cabinet are a unit in favor of traveling over the railroads hereafter as private citizens. Instead of lining palace cars, which have been found to be the cause of much complaint on the part of the officials, and in this way show that much sympathy for the cause of the laborers.

Exaggerated.

An Inter-Ocean Green Bay special says, the reports of the ravages of the fire at Eaton, Wisconsin, has been overdrawn. Over thirty families have been burned out, and in many instances the entire crop is destroyed. The loss is estimated at \$18,000. No lives were lost.

Train Stopped.

WILKESBARE, 7.—An attempt to move some trains at Waukegan, last evening, failing, owing to the strikers uncoupling the engine from the cars, the sheriff went out to-day with United States troops, and there was no further interference.

Physician Murdered.

TERRE HAUTE, Ind., 7.—Dr. J. B. Armstrong, a leading physician, was shot and killed in the northern suburbs of this city at 9 o'clock to-night. He was returning from a visit to a patient, the cause of the murder is a mystery.

Missing Matters.

WASHINGTON, 7.—The Interior Department has decided that an adverse claim to be considered must be sworn to by the party claiming adversely, and not by an attorney.

Hearings may be had to determine whether a legal expenditure has been made on a mine for which a patent is desired. The expenditure of more than \$1,000 by the owners of an adjoining mine on a portion of a tunnel running through the premises embraced in the application for a patent, in case the application is to be an interest in such tunnel, is considered an expenditure under the mining law upon a claim applied for.
