Preparations for the work, however, as authorized by Congress, have been commenced, and we may now reasonably hope for some good results visible. An appropriation by Congress of \$600,000 will be likely to keep the purpose in mind until accomplished. Of the national bank notes, the bills of the smaller denominations-five, tens and twen- ST. ties-will be first printed, and will probably occupy some three months of time in the preparation—Philadelphia Ledger.
