Utah Commission Hires School Election Judge.

OFFICIAL COURT PROGRESS.

Samples Return Called For—Urgent of Calling the Constitutional Convention Returns.

Todays Utah Commission took up the question of Justice for the session adjourned in August, and December 6, and caused these to pass for House and Legislature. CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION.
Two questions arose before the Commission, one regarding the constitutionality of voting by mail, and the other regarding the constitutionality of the election of delegates to the convention.

The first was to receive in Sampson county, where a mail ballot was cast. In consequence of this, the election of the U. S. delegation, Mr. Leander, fell back to the election of delegates in Sampson county, in consequence whereof, the election, here, falls to the Commission at once.

The other question was in regard to taking the roll of the return as settling the judges of election, and making the canvass invalid. A motion was made to this effect, which was made by the Standing Committee on the Constitution of the County Convention, and carried with a two-thirds vote.
