

# IS NOT WARRANTED.

Say the County Commissioners of Kane Board's Action.

At a meeting of the board of county commissioners held this morning, at which there were present, Commissioners Armstrong, Hall, Twining, Assistant County Attorney Phillips, Assessor Quinn and Auditor Galt, the action of the state board of equalization in raising the matched value to full lake county, 25 per cent, was considered in an amicable manner.

## CHIEFMAN ARMSTRONG GAVE IT AS HIS OPINION THAT THE ACTION OF THE STATE BOARD COMPLETELY IGNORED THE STATE CONSTITUTION, WHICH LIMITED THE TAX TO A CERTAIN AMOUNT, HIS SAID, THE BOARD, BY THE RAISE OF TAXING REVENUE, OR RAISE THE AMOUNT OF TAX, IT WAS JUST AS CERTAIN THAT IT WAS VIOLATING THE STATE CONSTITUTION.

Assessor Quinn characterized it as absolutely unjust, and said that it would be borne by the taxpayers.

## UNWARRANTED BY LAW.

After some further discussion the board accepted the following resolution:

Resolved, by the county commissioners of Kane county, that the action of the state board of equalization, in raising the matched value to full lake county, 25 per cent, is in violation of the state constitution, and is therefore, unjust and unwarranted by law.

Resolved, further, that the board protest this resolution in person to the board of equalization at its next session, August 11, 1897.

## CAUSE OF TODAY'S ACTION.

The action of the board of county commissioners today was based upon the following:

The state board of equalization served a notice upon County Auditor Margaret K. Galt, informing her that the matched value in Kane county would be raised 25 per cent. The commissioners were referred to the board of county commissioners, at a meeting held yesterday afternoon, and on motion was made the subject for a special meeting this morning.
