

BIG PREPARATIONS FOR CHARITY BALL

St. Mark's Aid Association Seeking Assistance for a Most Worthy Cause.

St. Mark's Hospital Charity Aid association is soon to give a ball to raise funds for its work during the coming year. It is hoped that the people of

Salt Lake will generously respond to this appeal for a worthy charity, the only one of its kind in the city. The association is composed of ladies of all denominations who give their time and services absolutely without compensation and purely for the work of relieving suffering. Any sick person who is destitute and in need of hospital care, regardless of race, creed or color, applying to the president of the association or the chairman of the charity committee, will have his or her case promptly attended to. St. Mark's hospital cares for the patients thus sent at cost.

This past year the association has had at the hospital 51 patients for 1517 days making an average of three and one-half patients a day for every day in the year. The cost of this has been \$2448.16, and at the present time the funds are exhausted, so that it is very necessary to make this charity ball a success if this good work is to be continued.

One instance may give some idea of the good done by the association. A child was sent to the hospital by the association last summer, suffering from a dislocated hip. She was 12 years old, and through the ignorance and poverty of her parents, had been neglected for years. She was suffering agonies and living in squalor, with the prospect of

being a helpless cripple. A kind friend brought her to the hospital, after traveling with her 40 miles by stage. She stayed three months and left completely cured, instead of being a cripple for life. If indeed she could have lived, this is only one of many instances of the help given by this association to relieve the sick and suffering poor. All the net receipts of the charity ball are used directly for the purpose described above, so that all who buy tickets, may know that they are aiding a very worthy cause.
