THE ELEPHANT AS A WAR NURSE



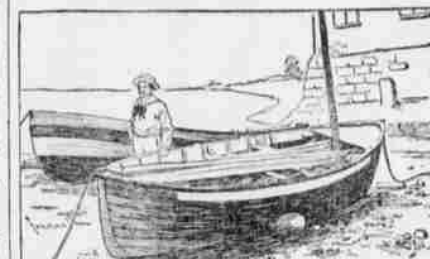
