

Healy, Parnell's secretary, and a member of the land league, was arrested yesterday on a charge of libeling a landlord in one of his speeches. Other arrests will follow.

The International Congress of Electricians will meet at Paris, Sept. 15, 1881. The congress will be preceded by an international exhibition of electrical appliances.

The erection of a memorial to perpetuate the labors of Thomas Clarkson as an advocate of slave emancipation, was begun Monday, at Wiesbach, when the first stone was laid.

The Turkish commissioner has proposed that negotiations be carried on at Kunia. He informed Montenegro that the Porte is prepared to surrender Dulcigno on the 1st of November.

Derrisch Pasha has been ordered to Dulcigno with three battalions, in consequence of a telegram from Kiza Pasha, reporting the Albanians resisting his measure for the cession of that town.

A duel has been fought between Gassier, of the Drama, and Juarez Miramon, son of the Mexican General Miramon, on account of certain allusions to the latter in the Drama. Miramon was wounded in the hand.

The Kurds invading Persia are reported 15,000 strong. They are in three divisions. The first division is 30 miles from Tarbiz, which is in danger. The inhabitants are barricading the streets. The Persian troops number 9,000.
