### JUSTICE MILLER'S FUNERAL.

Services to Take Place Tomorrow

WASHINGTON, Oct. 24.—The  
arrangements for Justice Miller's  
funeral were completed today. The  
funeral will take place Thurs-  
day afternoon, between 2 and 3  
o'clock, in the Supreme Court room  
of the United States building, ac-  
cording to the wishes of the family.  
The funeral will be of the simplest  
character, and the only religious  
service will be the reading of the  
scriptures and the offering of a  
prayer for the repose of the soul.  
The body will be placed in a  
special car attached to a regular  
train, and will leave for Chicago  
leaving here at 10:30 p.m., arriving  
at Chicago the following evening, and  
at Keokuk at 10 a.m. Saturday.  
The funeral at Keokuk will take place  
from the United States Church im-  
mediately after the arrival of the  
train. The body will be placed in a  
special car attached to a regular  
train, and will leave for Chicago  
leaving here at 10:30 p.m., arriving  
at Chicago the following evening, and  
at Keokuk at 10 a.m. Saturday.
