

A Most Remarkable Elevator

It Takes Passengers Up the Sides of the Burgenstock Mountain.

WHOM has not heard of this place, lying as it does in a long, grassy depression, surrounded by beautiful trees and rocks, near the summit of the Burgenstock Mountain?

The walks about here are particularly beautiful, opening up a new view at every turn. Should the visitor care to prolong his walk and obtain a more extended view, he can go out to the electric elevator, which is one of the most extraordinary lifts on the continent.

This was opened for the first time last month, and Dr. Guglielminetti, of Paris, who was present at the inauguration and one of the first to ascend, told me that the movement was heaven-like, and left the same impression upon him as when ascending in a balloon.

Morris, Lohle & Co., and Messrs. Wust & Co. of Zurich are the engineers and constructors of this remarkable undertaking, and it certainly is a triumph of engineering. It cost over 100,000 francs, and will be a decided attraction.


In looking at this lofty structure one can quite understand why it must have been so dangerous to erect. The workmen were from eight to ten months in doing it, and a great portion of the time they had to work with a rope bound round them, and for weeks in fixing or drilling for the iron supports they had to be lowered by ropes from the steep rocky cliff above.

The Lake of Lucerne is 1,468 feet above the sea, and the lift as completed starts from a point on the lake shore 1,000 feet higher, and rises some 600 feet, making a total of 3,000 feet above sea level. It carries from six to seven persons at a time, and the round trip is but a fraction. So Herr Bucher-Durrer, the owner, has no commercial object in view.

Every imaginable precaution has been taken in the construction to make the ascent absolutely free from any risk. The ironwork is made secure in several places to the perpendicular cliff, and the whole tower is connected with a bridge which unites the summit of this steel structure to the top of the mountain.

The dial is made of variegated plants so arranged that the hours are marked as distinctly as if they were painted. The hands are formed of shallow troughs containing growing plants and are set every day to show the hour of closing the park gates.

gratto excavated in the perpendicular rock, where also the machinery is placed. The first 220 feet of the shaft is tunneled through the live rock; above this is the iron tower, 280 feet high, in which the cage passes up outside the face of the rock to the platform above.

The whole construction, which is not only absolutely safe, but is most attractive, reminds one of the Eiffel tower.

At night it presents a pretty effect, showing a straight line upward on the sides of the mountain, with hundreds of

electric lights one above the other for 600 feet.—Burgenstock Letter to Paris Herald.
