

LIGHT BUSINESS IN MINING STOCKS

Day's Record was 51,125 Shares for the Sum of \$13,100.54.

PRICES DECLINED A LITTLE.

But Not Sufficient to Injure the Condition of the Market-Sales of the Day.

Business on the exchanges today was rather light, the whole amounting to 52,325 shares, for which buyers paid the sum of \$13,100.54. The market board showed sales of 50,000 shares for \$13,000, while the exchange made transfers totaling 26,000 shares for \$1,479.44. Stocks generally had a decreased tendency, the declines, however, being of a minor character, and not calculated to injure in any event the condition of the local market.

BUSINESS WAS FAIR.

Old Mining stocks, the numbers of which have been around out of a total volume of business at this meeting's call, the sales amounting to 50,000 shares, which had a value of \$13,000. In place there was a weakening in price, but nothing of sufficient magnitude to injure the market.
