

Threatened labor troubles are not believed to be serious, which helps the cow market, and the run is only 1400 head today, about two-thirds of recent average, and a high price is being bid. Cows are 10 to 15 cents better than low time last week. Fair Colorado cow brought \$3.75 and \$2.90 today. Fat steers steady, and salesmen are holding prices at a high level. High prices for buyers from the country are in sight. Most western stockers and feeders bring between \$2.75 and \$3.50. Some lambs sold at \$3.00 to \$3.50 some last week, the low time about Wednesday. Ewes also dropped below the \$3 mark and sold around \$2.50 to \$2.90. Fat wethers sold at \$3.00 to \$3.40, fed wethers not much changed, and fat \$3.00 to \$3.25. Lambs on the other hand closed around \$3.00 for best. Several big strings of feeding lambs were disposed of at \$2.50 to \$3.00. Fat ewes are selling at \$2.50 to \$3.00, and fat lambs are higher, selling at \$5.10. Fat wethers are strong, and ewes and feeders are weak to lower. Run last week 46,150 head.

The Susto tunnel, which intersects the Comstock lode at the 1,740-foot level, gives virtually a new surface level by which work can be prosecuted, says a San Francisco publication.
