

Dramatic AND Musical

In the little stir that has arisen over the mixing up of the names of the Salt Lake and Ogden choirs, it is not likely that any ill feeling will result, especially as the conductors of both choirs are almost like father and son in musical relationship. It was through the urgent advice of Prof. Stephens that Prof. Ballantine took up his especial line of work with Sabbath schools, Improvement associations and choirs, on his return from the east, and no one, even in Ogden, where the heartiest support has been given to Prof. Stephens by the state and Sabbath school authorities, can be said to have exceeded Prof. Stephens in actively backing up the Ogden leader's work. He has again and again pointed to him as an example of what he would have our specially trained and gifted young men be and do in their musical labors.

It may be noted that in the controversy over the use of the name "Mormon Tabernacle choir" not a hint of ill will or blame has been directed by one conductor against the other; both seem to regret that there should have been any misunderstanding by the Portland press in the matter. Of course each has the legitimate rights of his choir to guard and it has been rather unusual to see the Salt Lake choir to see it announced one day that they are going to Portland, and have to be told the next that it is another body. Besides, it could not fail to be unpleasant for the Ogden choir if the Salt Lake singers should be thought by many of the listeners that they were the ones whose financial and other success should be due to the reputation of the older organization.

The question of the quality of the work done by each or either is not a consideration. No one more thoroughly gives unselfish service to Ogden than the conductor than Mr. Stephens, and doubtless none in Ogden would be more ready to give him due acknowledgement than Prof. Ballantine.
