CHARGED WITH MURDER.

Arrest of a Man Who Shot His Sister's Seducer.

Early this morning Ezra Hale, of Hopkville, west of Ogden, was arrested by deputy marshals on a charge of murder. He was placed in jail, and is to have a preliminary examination in a day or two. Mr. Hale is said to have admitted that he fired one of the shots. His father-in-law, the shooting occurred on September 23, 1871, and James Hendry, who was shot, died the next day. The Ogden Junction gave the following particulars of the tragedy at the time of its occurrence:

"On Friday night the peace of the valley was disturbed by the shooting of a man named James Hendry. He was terribly wounded, and the contents of a double-barreled shotgun were discharged into his back. James Hale and his son were arrested on suspicion of having done the shooting. It appears that one of Hale's daughters, a married woman, whose husband resides at Springville, had quarreled with her spouse and returned to her father's home. Her father had great attention, and this coming to the ears of the father, he informed Hendry that his daughter was a married woman, and forbade his visits and attentions. The young man, however, persisted, and managed to get the young woman engaged as help to a relative of his. Under a promise of marriage he accomplished his seduction. Hendry then refused to fulfill his promise, and opened a breach in the favor he had received, killing the young woman by the foulest of crimes he could use."

"Hendry died on Saturday night, having previously confessed that he had promised marriage to Hale's daughter. The two Hales were brought to Ogden for examination, and were returned to their own place at Springville, and on their way back to Ogden both the prisoner and his wife were released. The universal feeling among the community is that Hendry richly deserved his fate."

CITY COUNCIL.

The Franchise Question Untouched.—Sewerage Again.

There was no session of the City Council last night, owing to there being no quorum present. As a result the matter of the franchise was not touched. The question of street car franchise, which was made the special order for last evening, therefore goes over for the present.

Councilor LeGrand Young called attention to a fact that has been established in these columns—that the volume of water in City Creek was greatly decreased in Pleasant Valley. He suggested that in order to prevent the great loss that goes on there, an aqueduct be constructed.

THE SEWERAGE.

Mayor Armstrong received the following from Engineer Lowrie:

DENVER, Colorado, August 4, 1888.

My Dear Sir—I now see that I have misunderstood your wishes. When last in Salt Lake I was recommended an extension of your outlet-sewer down the river some four miles, and looked over the route in view of the long stretches of light fall, I advised an increase of size to thirty inches, instead of twenty. It is impossible with one of your surface ditches to get a water carriage with such a run as your sewerage flow will suffice. Also, as the work will necessarily be done in the surface, sometimes above it, in a ditch, I advised the use of a flexible pipe. Now as this was not altogether from the plans before made you, and that chiefly in degree, I thought I had better look over the plan to do to inspect the profile of your outlet sewer, and to look over the impressions then obtained, and report you on this subject. I have now made a verbal report made while in your city. Now send drawings to illustrate the construction of this sewer. I will send full specifications on Monday. As the sewer will be the former plan will answer. I estimate this work will cost you, including iron covers and a few necessary shaft connections, about \$30 per foot.

Railway Accidents.

Yesterday a U. P. brakeman named J. Gallagher, was knocked from a passing freight train at Bridger and badly hurt, the spout of the water tank striking him on the hip as the train moved past. He was brought down to Ogden last evening and taken to the U. P. hospital and placed under the care of Dr. Perkins. His injuries were not as serious as at first anticipated, though his hip pains him a great deal, and he is unable to walk. Last Monday night a wreck occurred on the Union Pacific about six miles east of Ogden. The freight train was coming west when a coupling pin broke and the train pulled apart. It is believed that the accident was caused by getting out of the way, the engineer stopped the train. The other half came crashing into the first section, ditching six cars and smashing them badly. From passenger cars it was learned that the wreck was being cleared away when last evening's No. 1 passed the scene.—Ogden Standard, Aug. 2.

"Battle of Gettysburg."

The large circular building on West Temple street, just south of the Valley House, is now completed, and is ready for the exhibition to be given within its walls, which, as the sign in front indicates, is to be "The Battle of Gettysburg," by the Salt Lake Cyclorama Company. It is the first exhibition of the kind ever given in this part of the country, and if it comes anything near the panorama of the "Battle of Gettysburg," in Chicago, which the managers claim it does, it is a fine show. The panorama will be open to the public on Saturday evening, at 8:30, and will be open every evening, Sundays excepted, until further notice. The admission is placed at 50 cents.

Struck by a Train.

EUROPEAN NOTES.

Affairs in Serbia—Mackenzie's Reviewers—The Meeting of the Emperor and Queen—Disaffection in Alsace—British Notes—French Fragments.

The readers of the daily newspapers have every day the privilege of reading paragraphs on the "European Situation," which are supposed to give them the latest, most important and most trustworthy news from the other continent. At certain times, it is true, that all that is needed is to give the facts truthfully and without bias, not spending too much time in attempts at forecasting.

But when a correspondent begins to talk of "strained tensions," "disquieting situations," "antagonistic impressions," and "ruptured relations," you may be sure he has not much information to impart. To telegraph a guess one day and to telegraph a fact the next is an unenviable task to fill up the proper number of lines, but in no way less so to telegraph a stock of facts. True there is that great personage the "Paris correspondent," who, as an eminent French writer, daily presses the lightning into his service to instruct the New York Herald and the rest of mankind with the impression of things in general. It was rather hard on him the other day when he was accused of being a "great actor without knowing it." Then again a correspondent writes that he has seen a man who says that he has heard of Crivoieva, or of the considerable cattle that was frozen there the past spring? It may be safely asserted, not one in ten thousand; and all this because it is the interest of ruling powers to enforce silence in the affairs of the Balkan provinces. It may be well to remember that in Serbia, the throne, mingled with revolts and assassinations, have been the scene of bloodshed since 1817. Every prince whom Serbia has had since that time has fallen by a dagger or by a revolver.

King Milan and his beautiful wife Queen Natalie have had a serious quarrel and the queen has been driven away from her husband.
